

### **Q: What is a Beltsville Adventist Church Connect Group?**

A: Connect Groups are Beltsville Adventist Church's groups of 12 to 15 people that meet online via Zoom or in-person to learn more about the Bible, grow in their faith and meet some great new friends. Trust me, they're a lot of fun!

### **Q: What happens when I sign up for a Connect Group?**

A: When you sign up you will receive an email confirmation that you have been registered for the group.

Before the first meeting, the leader of your new Connect Group will contact you with the physical location of the Group's meeting place or a Zoom link, the date and time you'll be starting, and all the other information you'll need to have a great experience!

### **Q: How long does a Connect Group last?**

A: Connect Groups run for about 2 months or 8 sessions. This can vary by individual group as sometimes a group will take a week off. Your Connect Group leader will provide details after you sign up.

### **Q: How often does a Connect Group meet?**

A: Connect Groups meet once a week online or in-person, and each meeting is just sixty to ninety minutes long. Your Connect Group leader will provide details once you sign up.

### **Q: Do I need to buy anything?**

A: It doesn't cost anything to register for and attend any Connect Group.

However, depending on what your Connect Group will be doing you may need to purchase a book (if your group will be reading one) or other supplies. The description of the Connect Group on the website should have that information. Additional information will be sent to you by your group leader.

### **Q: Do I have to be a member of the Beltsville SDA Church to join a group?**

A: Connect Groups are open to anyone who is interested! Invite your friends and neighbors to join us!

### **Q: Where do the groups meet?**

A: Connect Groups will meet either in-person or online. If the group that you register for meets in-person, you should see that information on the website. If the group meets online, you will receive a link for a Zoom meeting from your group leader before the first meeting.
